Logic

Logic Puzzle

Tess cultivated the Bossa Nova ivy (Given 4), so her ivy doesn't have the bird's-foot-shaped leaves (Given 1), the heart-shaped leaves (Given 3), the variegated leaves, which is the shape of the leaves on the ivy called Four Star (Given 3), or the curly leaves (Given 4); it has the fan-shaped leaves. The ivy with the bird's-foot-shaped leaves had a problem with whiteflies (Given 1). The ivy with heart-shaped leaves had a problem with mealy bugs (Given 3). Lena's ivy, which is called Queen Regent (Given 2), doesn't have the bird's-foot-shaped leaves or the heart-shaped leaves (Given 2), it has the curly leaves. Donald's ivy had a problem with aphids (Given 5), so his ivy has variegated leaves. Phillip's ivy doesn't have the bird's-foot-shaped leaves (Given 1); it has the heart-shaped leaves. Holly's ivy has the bird's-foot-shaped leaves, which had the problem with whiteflies, so her ivy isn't called Jade Eye (Given 4); it's called Yankee Stem. Phillip grew the ivy called Jade Eye. Tess, whose ivy has the fan-shaped leaves, didn't battle leaf spot (Given 5); her ivy had spider mites. Lena's ivy had leaf spot.

In summary:

Donald: Four Star, Variegated, Aphids

Holly: Yankee Stem, Bird's Foot, Whiteflies

Lena: Queen Regent, Curly, Leaf Spot

Phillip: Jade Eye, Heart, Mealy Bugs

Tess: Bossa Nova, Fan, Spider Mites
