Trek Trivia

TOS: Genghis Khan, Zora, Kahless, and Colonel Green

TNG: Cadet Jean-Luc Picard (Note: Captain Jean-Luc Picard is wrong because he was only a Cadet at the time)

DS9: "Moogie"

VOY: Chief Warrant Officer

Logic

1. This body was missing what only Adam or Eve would be missing: a belly button.

Logic Puzzle

Grades are 90, 92, 94, 96, and 98 (introduction). Kenneth got a 92 on his paper (Given 2). The one whose paper received a 90 is not Posey, David (Given 1), or Francesca (Given 3). Therefore, it was Valerie who received the grade of 90. David described a battering ram (Given 1). The one whose paper received a 96 described a mangonel (Given 2). Valerie, whose paper received a 90, did not describe an onager (Given 3) or a catapult (Given 4). Therefore, she described a trebuchet. The paper that scored 98 did not describe an onager (Given 3) or a catapult (Given 4). Therefore, it described a battering ram. Posey's paper got a 96 and Francesca's got a 94 (Given 1), so the paper describing the onager received a 92 and the one about the Battle of Whitestone received a 90 (Given 3). The paper that described a catapult got a 94, so the one about the Queen's Folly received a 92 (Given 4). Francesca's paper, which described a catapult, is not about the Battle of Gray Guard (Given 1) or Mondovi Ridge (Given 4). Instead, it is about the Battle of Alford. David's paper, which received a 98, is not about the Battle of Mondovi Ridge (Given 4) but instead about the Battle of Gray Guard. Posey's paper is about the Battle of Mondovi Ridge.

In summary:

David: Gray Guard, Battering Ram, 98

Francesca: Alford, Catapult, 94

Kenneth: Queen's Folly, Onager, 92

Posey: Mondovi Ridge, Mangonel, 96

Valerie: Whitestone, Trebuchet, 90
